## Privacy Policy

At Crosshaven Rugby Football, Club (“Crosshaven RFC”), we understand that privacy is an important issue for users of (and visitors to) the Crosshaven RFC website [www.crosshavenrugbyfc.com](http://www.crosshavenrugbyfc.com) and its related domains. The following information is designed to help visitors understand what information we collect from our site, and how we handle and use the information after that.

### **Information Collection and Use**

Crosshaven RFC is the sole owner of any information collected on this site. We will not sell, share, or rent this information to others in ways different from what is disclosed in this statement. Crosshaven RFC may collect information from our users at several different points on our website.

### **General Enquiries**

If a User contacts Crosshaven RFC with a request to become a member, the User may need to provide Crosshaven RFC with personal information (for example contact details, date of birth etc.). Crosshaven RFC will use this personal information to enrol the user as a member and track further correspondence and will use this information to compile a members’ database for Club purposes and to satisfy the requirements of the Munster Branch of the IRFU and the IRFU. Personal information collected is not used for any other purpose.

### **Cookies**

Cookies are small text files that a site transfers to a user’s (visitor’s) hard disk or browser for added functionality or for tracking site usage. In order to measure the effectiveness of our online presence, Crosshaven RFC may use cookies to determine the path users take on our site and to identify repeat users of our site. We do not use cookies to gather personal information such as a person’s name or e-mail address.

## **Your Rights**

- To have your personal data corrected if inaccurate.
- The right to erasure where the personal data is no longer necessary for compliance with our legal obligations.
- To prevent your personal data from being used for certain purposes apart from the purposes you have consented to.
